

Closed Session II – September 5, 2006

At 6:05 p.m., the Board, already in closed session on another matter, began discussion on a different matter relating to the location or expansion of business in the area served by the Board, pursuant to N.C.G.S. 143-318.11(a)(4). Commissioners Holmes, Kemp, Frye, Lanier and Davis were present, as well as County Manager Richard Wells; Assistant County Manager/Finance Officer Will Massie; County Attorney Alan Pugh; Aimee Scotton, Associate County Attorney; Cheryl Ivey, Clerk to the Board; Amanda Jones, Deputy Clerk to the Board; and Bonnie Renfro and Harry Lane from Randolph County Economic Development Corporation (EDC).

Bonnie Renfro, Executive Director of Randolph County Economic Development Corporation, updated the Board on Project Ginseng, which is a cereal producing company interested in the old Unilever food facility in Asheboro. She said that the legal work should be completed soon on the deal and that she would be contacting both the County and City of Asheboro around mid-September to schedule a public hearing on the incentives package.
