The Randolph County Board of Commissioners met in special session at 1:15 p.m. at the Trinity City Hall Annex, 6703 NC Hwy. 62; Trinity, NC. Commissioners Holmes, Lanier and Haywood were present. Pursuant to Session Law 2009-403 (House Bill 1452), governing boards of counties (among others) are required to adopt a code of ethics, and each board member must also receive two hours of ethics training by Jan. 1, 2011.
